

PAALAK PANEER

INGREDIENTS

- Finely Chopped Onion 2 pcs
- Tomato Paste 2 tbsp
- Spinach Paste 500 Grams
- Garlic paste 1 tsp
- Kasuri methi 1 tsp
- Finely chopped ginger and red chilli 1.5 tbsp
- Fresh Cream 2 Tbsp
- Bay Leaf 2 pcs
- Pepper 10 pcs
- Cinnamon, Cardamom & Cloves 2 pcs each
- Cumin 1 tsp
- Oil 4 tbsp
- Asafetida 1/4 tsp
- Coriander powder 1 tbsp
- Turmeric Powder 1/2 tsp
- Black salt 1/2 tsp
- salt as per taste
- cumin powder 1 tsp
- Kashmiri red chilli 1 tsp
- Garam masala 1 tsp
- Paneer 200 Gram

INSTRUCTIONS

- Heat a pan over medium flame and add 4 tablespoons of oil.
- Once the oil is hot, add cumin seeds, asafoetida, bay leaves (2 pieces), peppercorns (10 pieces), cinnamon sticks (2), cardamom pods (2), and cloves (2 pieces). Mix well and fry until fragrant.
- Add finely chopped onions and a pinch of salt. Cook until the onions turn golden brown.
- Stir in chopped ginger, green chilies, and garlic paste. Roast on low flame until aromatic.
- Add tomato paste and mix well.
- Cut paneer into small pieces.
- Add red chili powder, cumin powder, salt to taste, black salt, turmeric powder, and coriander powder to the pan. Mix everything well.
- Add Kasuri methi and cook for 2 minutes.
- Mix in the Palak Paste (boil 500 grams of water, let it cool, then grind the spinach into a paste). Combine well.
- Close the lid and cook for 2 minutes.
- Add paneer cubes and garam masala. Mix well.
- If the Palak Paneer is too thick, adjust the consistency by adding water. Close the lid and cook for another minute.
- Turn off the flame and add cream. Mix well.
- Your Palak Paneer is now ready to be enjoyed. Bon appétit!

INGREDIENTS

- Speghetti-200grams
- Butter -2spoons
- Prawns -100grams
- Pepper -2pinch
- Salt -for taste
- Chillyflakes -2pinch
- Garlic 2 cubes
- Parmesan cheese 50gram

INSTRUCTIONS

- Boil the spaghetti in hot water for approximately 10 minutes until it's al dente, then drain and set aside.
- In a pan, melt 2 tablespoons of butter over medium heat. Add 2 finely chopped cloves of garlic and the prawns to the pan. Allow them to fry for about 2 minutes until the prawns are cooked.
- Add the boiled spaghetti to the pan, mixing it well with the garlic and prawns.
- Season the dish with salt and pepper to taste, adding a couple of pinches of both for flavor. For an extra kick, sprinkle in 2 pinches of chili flakes, adjusting according to your preference for spiciness.
- Once everything is well combined and heated through, transfer the Spaghetti alle Vongole to a serving dish.
- To finish, garnish the dish with a generous sprinkle of Parmesan cheese for added flavor and richness.
